## Student Ministry Team Requirements

Being a part of the Ministry Team is both a privilege and a challenge. We believe true leaders are servant-leaders. Each student who wants to serve in this capacity must be:

### **FAITHFUL**

- A committed Christian who loves God and loves people and desires to grow in your relationship with Jesus Christ.
- A growing faith evidenced by spending consistent personal time with the Lord and be willing to be held accountable for it.
- Putting forth your best efforts when working with the other team members, demonstrating servant leadership and resolving conflicts Biblically.

### **AVAILABLE**

- Willing to attend all Ministry Team meetings. (Ministry Team Meetings are held on these Sundays from 1-3pm: Oct 4, Nov 1, Dec 13, Jan 3, Feb 7, Mar 7, Apr 4, May 2)
- Arrive on time, bringing a Bible and a pen, for team meetings.
- Ready to serve where needed

### **TEACHABLE**

- A heart that is teachable.
- Willing to be open to do new things that might take you out of your comfort zone or be different from your personal preference.
- Willing to support EFC SH events through your presence, prayers, and hard work.
- Willing to help plan and coordinate opportunities for the SH youth ministry.
- Are part of a Bible-based church family and regularly attend that church.

### **RESPECTFUL OF / RESPONSIVE TO AUTHORITY**

- Willing to respond positively to correction.
- Submissive to the authorities over you.
- Respect your leaders, verbally supporting them both in public and private.

### **FINAL REQUIREMENT**

- You must be someone who loves to have fun while serving Christ!
